2. Game 2 will start at 4:00 on the Main Field with 15 minutes of infield for each team starting at 3:30 PM.

# **The Cameron County Little League Complex and the twenty eight year history of the Senior League Baseball State Tournament.**

In 1981, the ADA from Emporium was informed that the Senior League state baseball tournament was having problems finding leagues to host them. As an ADA and umpire at the time from Cameron County, Glen Feibig asked his League if they would like to try it. They agreed and ran the tournament. The tournament at that time was 14 and 15 year olds with four sections. They had a great time and made -\$128.00. The governor at that time, Richard Thornburg came and threw out the first ball, The State DA's at that time decided to make the site permanent. That was the beginning of the Tournament History.

The Cameron County Little League was formed in 1952 when Carl Stokes came to Cameron County and met with the Founders Al Kulick and Bill Bearly. It has since grown from just Majors to a full Baseball and Softball League. The fields have been refurbished several times with safety features, lights and new dugouts. But the basic fields are still the same size as in the beginning.

The senior field, which is used by Juniors, Seniors, High School and Legion is 300 feet down the right field line and 305 feet down the left field line. The center field flag pole is 360 feet from home but the entire out field fence is now 20 feet high. We fell this is a perfect field for seniors and our High School team hit seventeen home runs this year while the opposition hit three. The home run is part of the game and you have a hard time getting them on a pro field. By the way, I noticed that the High School State finals this year had no home runs in the four games played at the Altoona pro complex. (325-410-325)

Yes Cameron County is the smallest county in the state with a population of about 5,600 but we'll match anyone with our hospitality and wild life which some times come to the ball park. So don't chase the deer or bear off the field and please don't step on any rattle snakes. They just want to get water from the best trout stream in the state that is 25 feet from the field. We have no luxurious hotels, but the motel across the street from the field has the best breakfast for the least amount anywhere in the state. Your players will be fed by the women of the Moose, the K of C, the Rotary and the Recreation in a food tent. These organizations have been doing this for years because you see, **THIS IS A COMMUNITY EVENT FOR YOUR PLAYERS AND FUN FOR OUR CITIZENS.**

We have to remind all that are planning to attend that **NO FOOD, NO PETS, NO COOLERS AND NATURALLY NO ALCOHOL** are **ALLOWED**. The complex is private property owned by the Little League and the concession stand is considered the back bone of the league and is considered the best in District Ten. We also remind you that **ZERO TOLERANCE IS THE WORD OF THE DAY**. Everyone including the Umpires, who are High School and college trained, are volunteers. We will **NOT** tolerate any negative comments to anyone on the complex. We hope you enjoy your stay.
