History Of The Old Forge Little League

The Old Forge Lions Little League was founded in 1950 by Cyril Bosak. He was one of the original sponsors, and a team continues to be sponsored today by the Bosak family in his honor. In 2003, we added a girls' softball program to the offerings of the league, and in 2005 the Major League girls won the district championship. The Old Forge Little League boasts a program that has always been very successful, including a total of seven district championships, a section 4 championship (1978), a second place finish in the overall state tournament, three District 17 City - County championships, two city championships, and one county championship. The league currently consists of one senior league baseball team, three junior league baseball teams, two junior league softball teams, five major league baseball teams, three major league softball teams, three minor league baseball teams, two minor league softball teams, four t-ball baseball teams, and two "pony league" teams.
