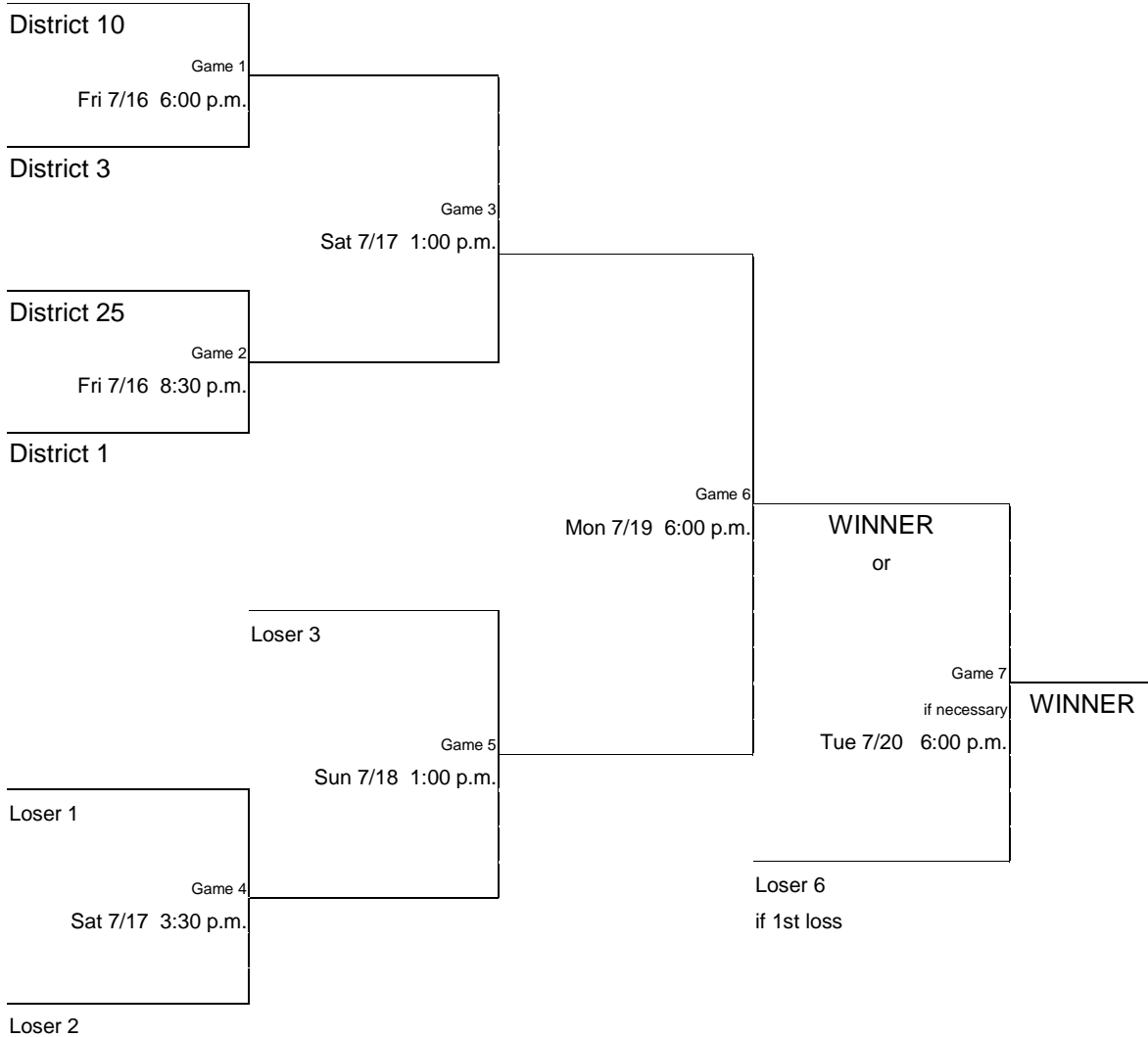
ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY
