**KAU NVF Senior Field-200 West South Street, Kennett Square, PA 19348**

KAU Senior Field (Seniors, Juniors): The KAU Senior Field (also known as the NVF Field) is located in Kennett Square on South Street just west of Harvey Circle

**Directions from the North or East:** From Rt. 202, take Rt. 1 South past Longwood Gardens and the Longwood Village Shops. Just after you pass Wendy's, the Hilton Gardens Hotel and Wal-Mart, do NOT take the Kennett Square exit, but continue on Rt. 1 South as it becomes a four-lane divided highway. The next exit will be "Rt. 82 Unionville/Kennett Square". Exit here and turn left at the top of the exit ramp onto N. Union Street, cross back over Rt. 1

**Directions from the South or West:** Take Rt. 1 North to the exit marked "Rt. 82 Kennett Square/Unionville". Turn right at the top of the exit ramp.

Directions: Continue south on Union St. (Rt. 82) through the center of Kennett Square and continue south until you see the Kennett High School ahead on your left. Just before reaching the High School, turn right onto South Street at the light (by the Landhope Farms convenience store). Continue on South St. past Center St, past Harvey Circle (twice) until the road jogs to the left. Just before the road jogs to the left, turn right into an alley that leads to the field. There is a sign KAU Senior Field.

## **Tournament Rules and Procedures Highlights**

1. Tournament Rules and Regulations as published by Little League Baseball shall be binding, abided by and enforced.
2. All teams will submit their Eligibility Affidavits to the Tournament Director prior to each game. These affidavits must be verified immediately after the game (signed) and returned to the respective teams. Your team was given a Brown Envelope from your District Administrator titled **“Residency Documents for District Champions”** this envelope must contain all documents described on it and must be turned over to the game director before your first game.
3. Each manager MUST have in his or her possession, a medical release signed by the parent/guardian for each player listed on the eligibility affidavit.
4. Players, managers, coaches and spectators that become involved in any misconduct, on or off the field, may be dismissed from the tournament. The activity and person will be reported to the Little League Headquarters Tournament Committee, the parent league District Administrator and the League President.
5. The team manager is responsible for uniforms and equipment. All players must be in uniform, with the Little League approved patch. Equipment will be checked by the Game Director or Umpire-In-Chief prior to each game.
6. Only the team manager, two coaches and players listed on the official affidavit are permitted in the dugout or on the playing field.
7. All batting helmets must be NOCSAE approved with the warning labels.
8. Catchers must wear a mask with approved helmet meeting NOCSAE specifications and standards (skullcap type not acceptable) and throat guard.
9. Jewelry will not be allowed on the playing field regardless of the material. This includes earrings, necklaces, rings and watches. Medical alert items are permitted.
10. Tobacco/Tobacco products shall not be allowed in the dugouts or playing field.
11. Home Team Selection. The game field is neutral for each game. A coin-flip will determine home/visiting teams. The team traveling the longest distance will call the coin-flip.
12. Fifteen minutes prior to the game start, managers, coaches, umpires and the Game Director will meet at home plate to review the ground rules and answer pre-game questions.
13. Game balls will be supplied by the host District.
14. Dugout assignments. The schedule distributed shows two teams for each game. The team listed in the left column (or on the top of the official bracket) will occupy the First Base Dugout. The second column (or bottom of the official bracket) team will occupy the Third Base Dugout.
15. Both teams will meet at the home plate area immediately at the conclusion of the game and shake hands.
16. At the conclusion of the tournament, the winning team will be awarded a championship flag and pins for each participant. The runner-up team will be awarded pins for each participant.
