By Agreement of the PA State District Administrators, your team will not be permitted to compete in the tournament if you do not have a properly completed Little League International Tournament Documentation envelope including birth certificates, proof-of-residence documents, any appropriate waivers, and a league boundary map.

PA District 27 believes strongly that all games are to be decided on the field by the players according to the Little League Official Regulations and Playing Rules. In particular, rule XIV(a) – Field Decorum will be strictly enforced:

(a) The actions of players, managers, coaches, umpires and league officials must be above reproach. Any player, manager, coach, umpire or league representative who is involved in a verbal or physical altercation, or an incident of unsportsmanlike conduct at the game site or any other Little League activity is subject to disciplinary action by the Local League Board or Directors (or by the district, if the Big League is administered as a district operation).

Any unsportsmanlike action by players, manager, coaches, or fans from the opposing team to disrupt the play of any player, especially the pitcher, will be dealt with immediately. PA District 27 expects the manager and coaches to control their fans.

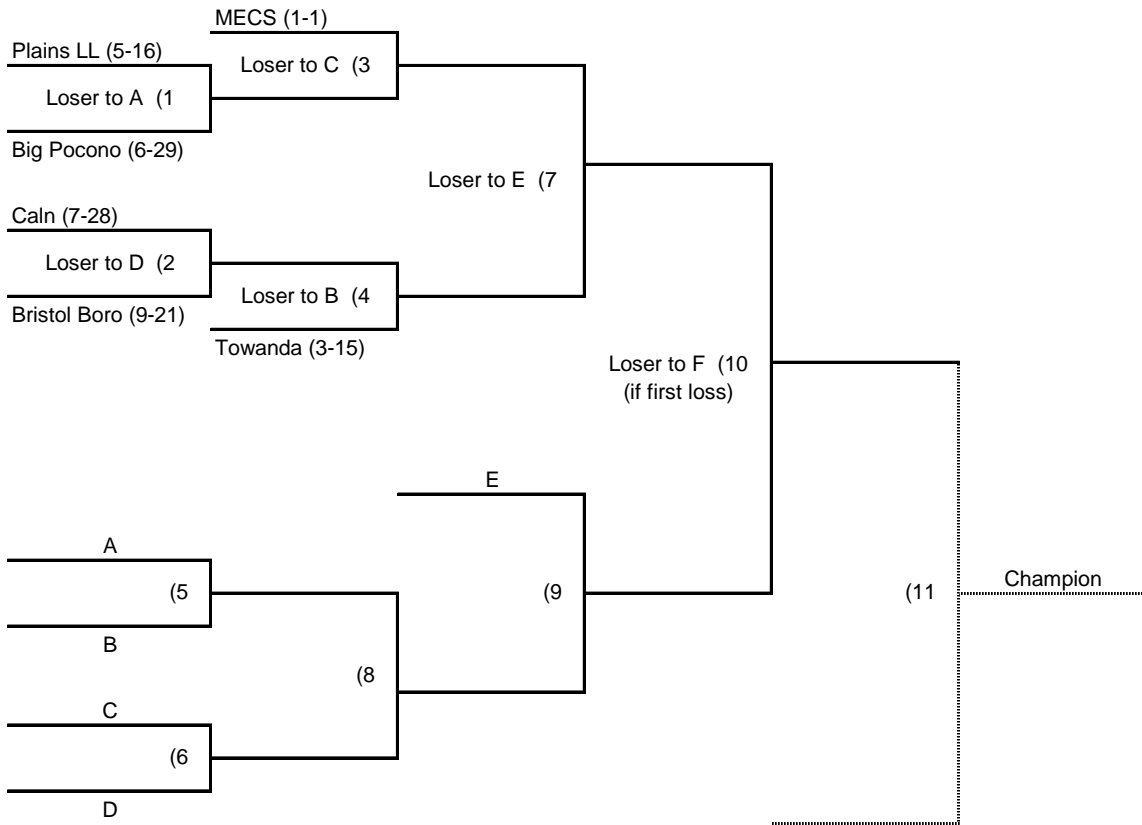

PA STATE TOURNAMENT RULES AND PROCEDURES HIGHLIGHTS

**“GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP IS THE HALLMARK OF ALL SUCCESSFUL
LITTLE LEAGUE TOURNAMENTS”**

1. The Tournament Rules and Regulations as published by Little League Baseball shall be binding, abided by and strictly enforced.
2. All teams will submit their **eligibility affidavits** to the Tournament Director prior to the tournament start. The affidavits will remain in possession of the Tournament Director until your team is eliminated or the tournament ends. The pitching record on the affidavit will be verified **immediately** after each game with each manager.
3. Each manager is encouraged to have, in his or her possession, a **medical release** signed by the parent/legal guardian for each player listed on the eligibility affidavits.
4. Players, managers, and coaches that become involved in any **misconduct**, on or off the field, or at their lodging, may be dismissed from the tournament. The activity and person will be reported to the Little League Headquarters Tournament Committee, the parent league District Administrator and the League President.
5. The team manager is responsible for **uniforms and equipment**. All players must be in uniform, with the Little League approved patch.
6. Only Manager, Coaches, and Players listed on the official tournament eligibility affidavit are permitted in the dugout or playing field.
7. All **batting helmets** must be NOCSAE approved with the warning labels.
8. **Catchers** must wear a mask with approved helmet (skullcap type not permitted) and throat guard.
9. No jewelry will be allowed on the playing field regardless of the material. This includes earrings, necklaces, rings, and watches. Medical alert items **ARE PERMITTED**.
10. **Tobacco**/Tobacco products shall not be allowed in the dugouts or playing field.

11. Game balls will be supplied by the host District.
12. A short infield/outfield warm-up will be allowed on the game field prior to the game only for the first time the team plays on that particular field (assumes conditions permit)
13. **Dugout Assignment:** The schedules distributed show two teams for each game. The team listed in the left column (or on the top of the official bracket) will occupy the First Base Dugout. The second column (or on the bottom of the official bracket) team will occupy the Third Base Dugout.
14. **Home Team Selection:** The game field is neutral for each game. A coin-flip will determine home/visiting teams. The team traveling the longest distance will call the coin-flip.
15. Thirty minutes prior to the game start, managers, coaches, umpires and the game director will meet at home plate to conduct the coin-flip, review the ground rules and answer any pregame questions.
16. Both teams will line-up as directed by the tournament director when introduced and remain there for the National Anthem and the Little League Pledge.
17. Both teams will meet at the home plate area immediately at the conclusion of the game and shake hands.
18. **Complimentary refreshments** will be served to both teams after the game.
19. At the conclusion of the tournament, the PA State Senior Girls Softball Champion will be awarded a championship flag. State pins will be awarded to all participants.

A brief meeting with tournament officials will take place for all managers and coaches to review field conditions and answer any questions before the start of the tournament.

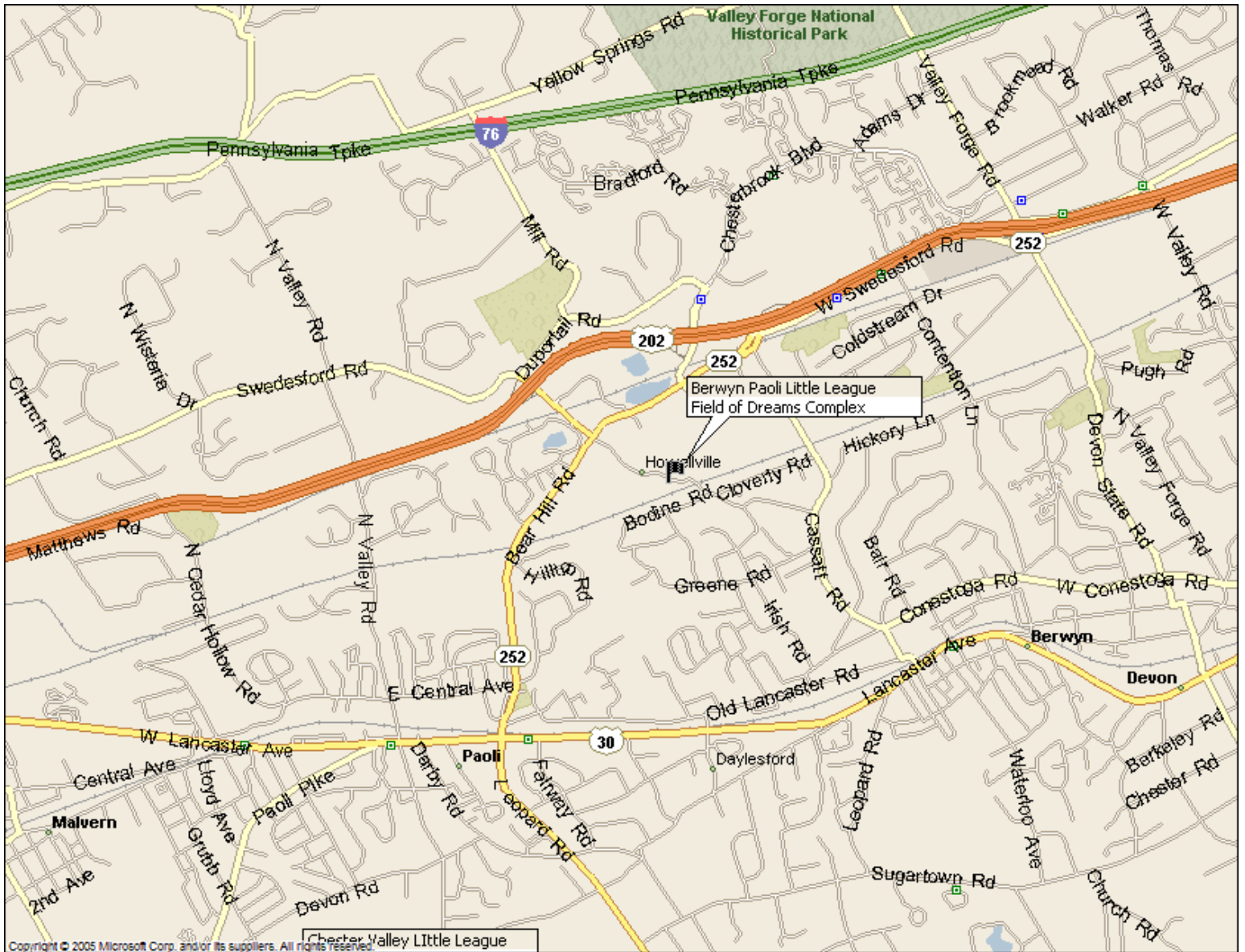
Hotel Information

Radio Broadcasting

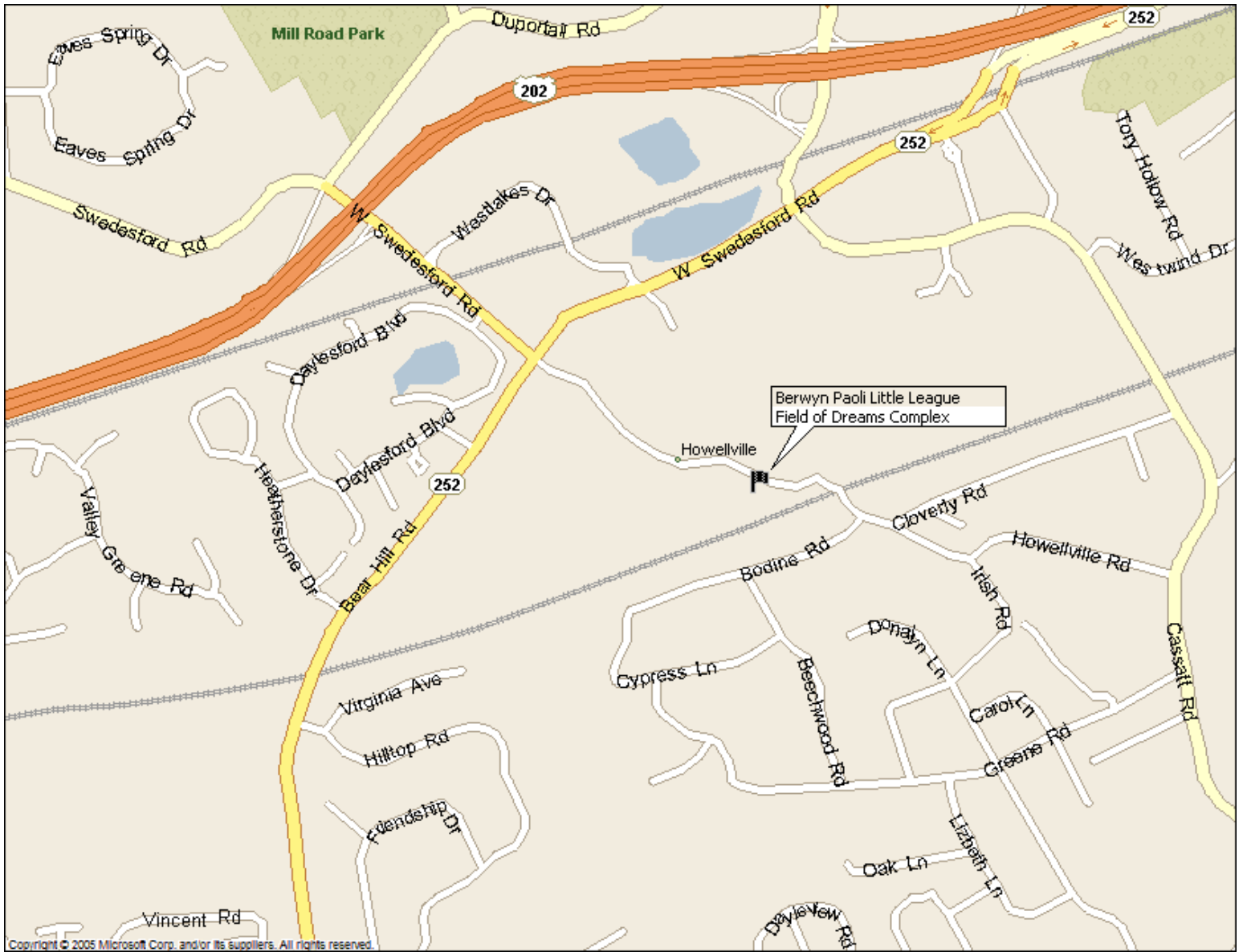

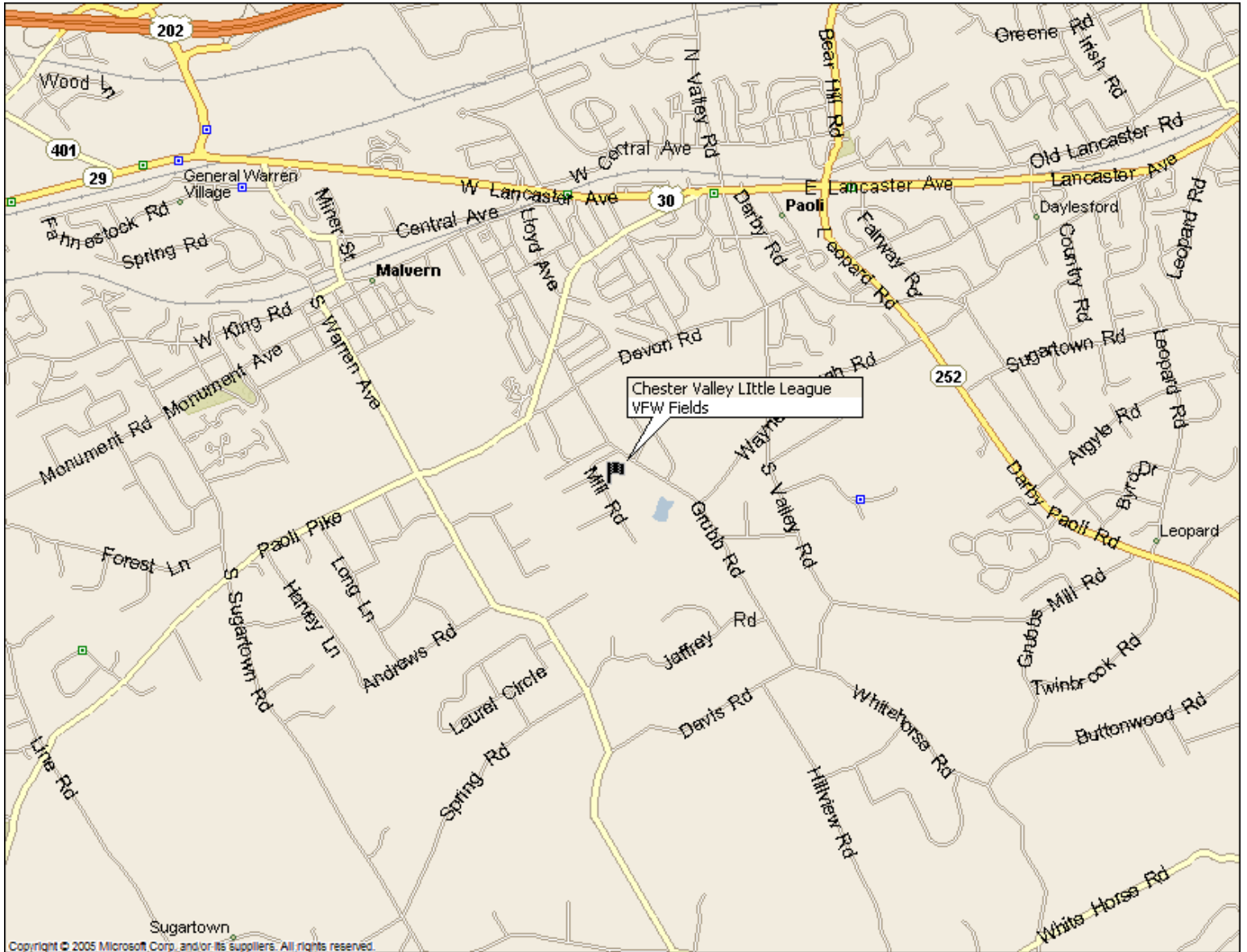

<p>From North</p> <p>Take Route 422 EAST to Route 202 SOUTH. Exit at Route 252 SOUTH (Paoli). Go to the THIRD traffic light (Howellville Road on the LEFT, Swedesford Road on the RIGHT) and turn LEFT onto Howellville Road. Field of Dreams is 1/4 mile on the RIGHT.</p>	<p>From South</p> <p>Take Route 252 NORTH and cross Route 3 and Route 30 (in Paoli). Go to the SECOND traffic light (Howellville Road on the RIGHT, Swedesford Road on the LEFT) and turn RIGHT onto Howellville Road. Field of Dreams is 1/4 mile on the RIGHT.</p>
<p>From East</p> <p>Take PA Turnpike WEST to Exit 24. Shortly after toll booth, take Route 202 SOUTH exit towards West Chester. Exit at Route 252 SOUTH (Paoli). Go to the THIRD traffic light (Howellville Road on the LEFT, Swedesford Road on the RIGHT) and turn LEFT onto Howellville Road. Field of Dreams is 1/4 mile on the RIGHT.</p>	<p>From West</p> <p>Take PA Turnpike EAST to Exit 24 and follow directions From East. Or, Take 202 NORTH to the Paoli (Swedesford Road) Exit. At the bottom of the exit ramp, turn right onto Swedesford Road. Follow Swedesford Road across Route 252 and it becomes Howellville Road. Field of Dreams is 1/4 mile on the RIGHT.</p>

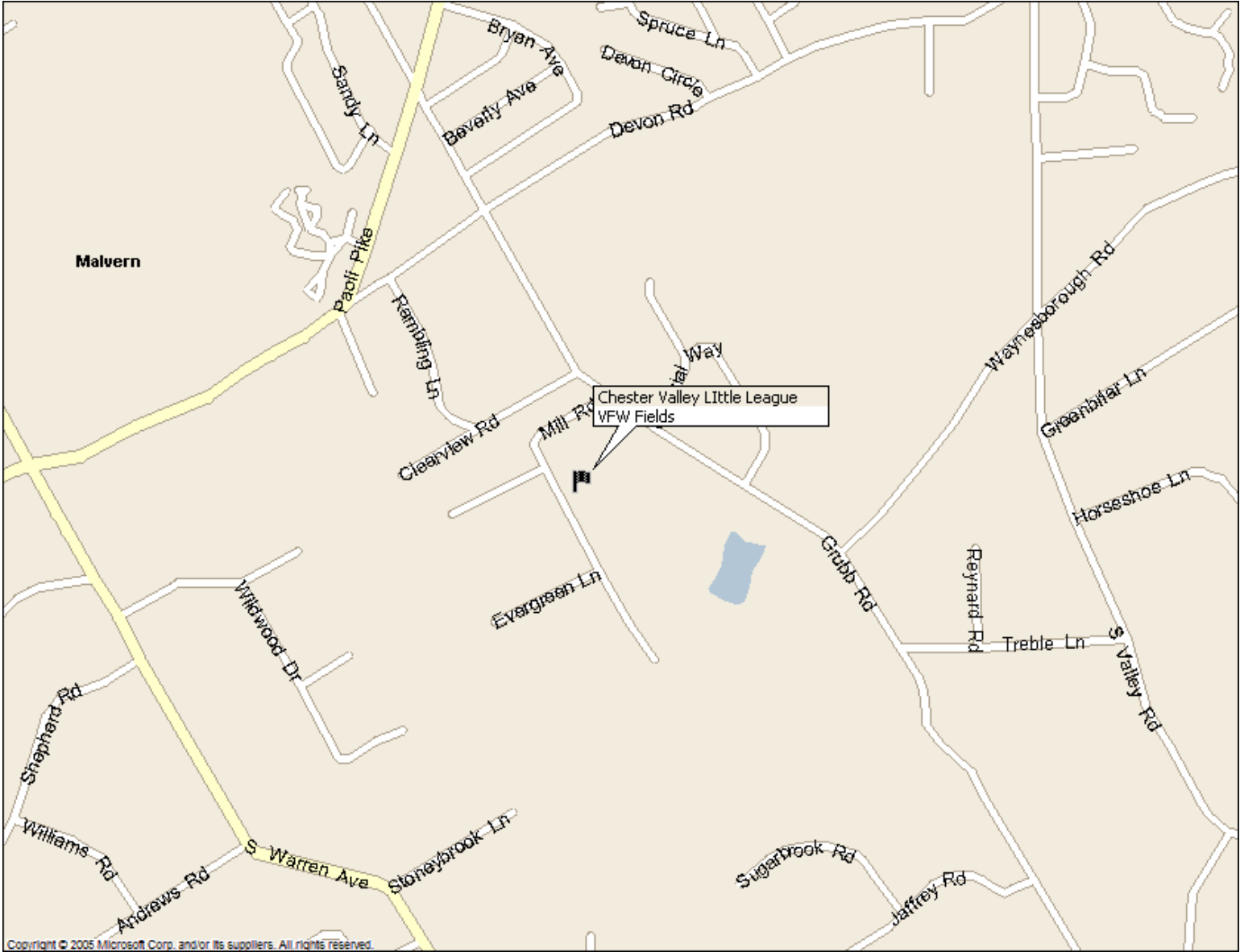

<p>From North</p> <p>From the King of Prussia Interchange (326) of the PA Turnpike, take Route 202 West towards West Chester. After about 4 miles, take the Route 252 (W. Swedesford Road) exit towards Paoli. Go under a railroad underpass and turn RIGHT onto Route 30 West (E. Lancaster Avenue). After one-half mile, bear LEFT at the traffic light onto Paoli Pike. Matthews Ford is at the intersection. Follow Paoli Pike for about 1 mile and turn LEFT at the STOP sign onto Grubb Road. General Wayne Elementary School is on the left. . At the St. Thomas Mar Thoma Church, turn RIGHT onto Mill Road. Follow road as it turns left and the fields will be on the LEFT.</p>	<p>From South</p>
<p>From East</p>	<p>From West</p> <p>From the Downingtown Interchange (312) of the PA Turnpike, take Route 100 South towards Exton. As you pass the Exton Mall on the LEFT and the West Whiteland Towne Center on the RIGHT, approach the intersection of Routes 100 and 30. Turn LEFT at the light onto Route 30 East. Follow Route 30 East. Pass Church Farm School and go under Route 202. As you approach the Route 202 overpass, stay in the LEFT lane as Route 30 will become single lane after a few lights. Once in Frazer, take a RIGHT onto Route 352 (Sproul Road). You'll pass a small strip mall on the right with the Frazer Post Office just before Route 352. Route 352 is the first RIGHT at the light past the strip mall. At the next traffic light, make a LEFT onto W. King Road. Stay on King Road through Malvern. Once past Warren Avenue (Traffic Light), watch for Grubb Road on the right. Turn RIGHT onto Grubb Road. Pass one traffic light and one stop sign. You will see General Wayne Elementary School on the left. At the St. Thomas Mar Thoma Church, turn RIGHT onto Mill Road. Follow road as it turns left and the fields will be on the LEFT.</p>
